







DeWitt County, TX had an October 2020 unemployment rate of 5.83%, increasing from 3.98% 5 years before.




Millennials

DeWitt County, TX has 3,715 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,157.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in DeWitt County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 5,927 people 55 or older, while there are 6,824 here.
















Top Industry Earnings


