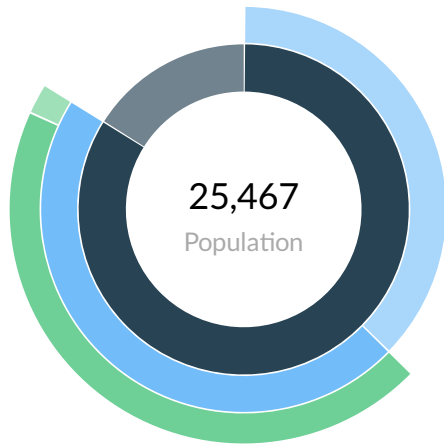
Median household income is **\$4.0K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 1.2%** in Fayette County, TX from 11,086 to **10,951**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 7.4%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 60.5% to 55.6% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Fayette County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.1% below the national average), and **5.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

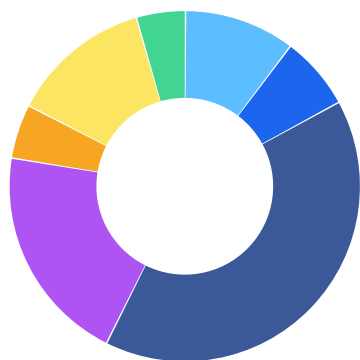

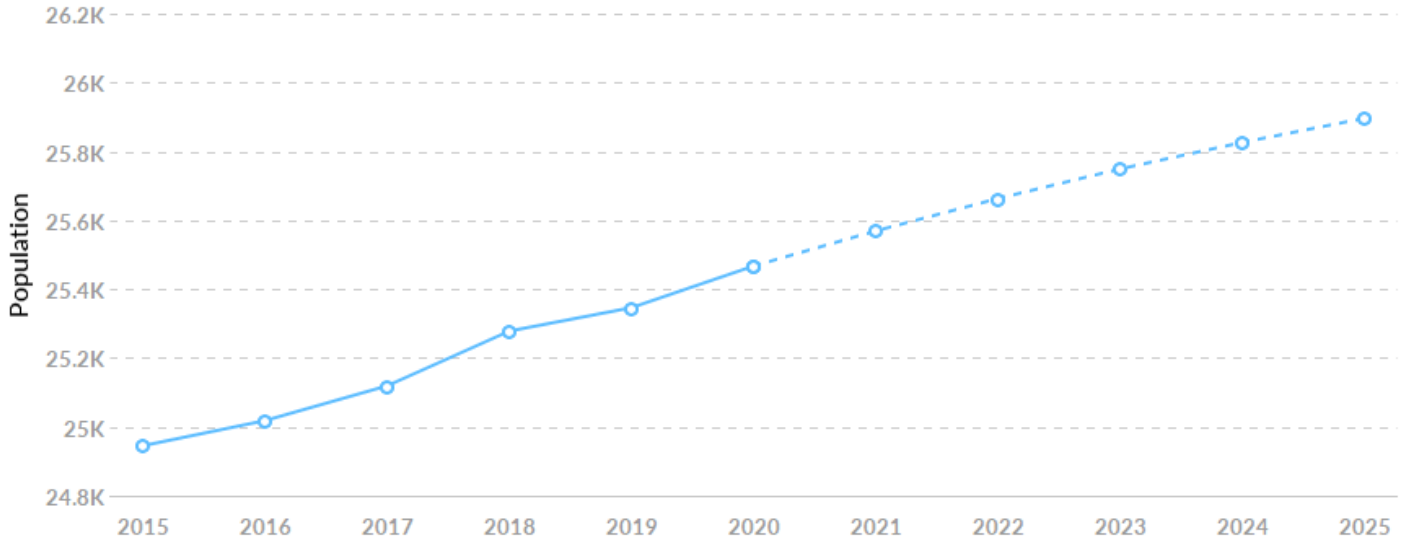

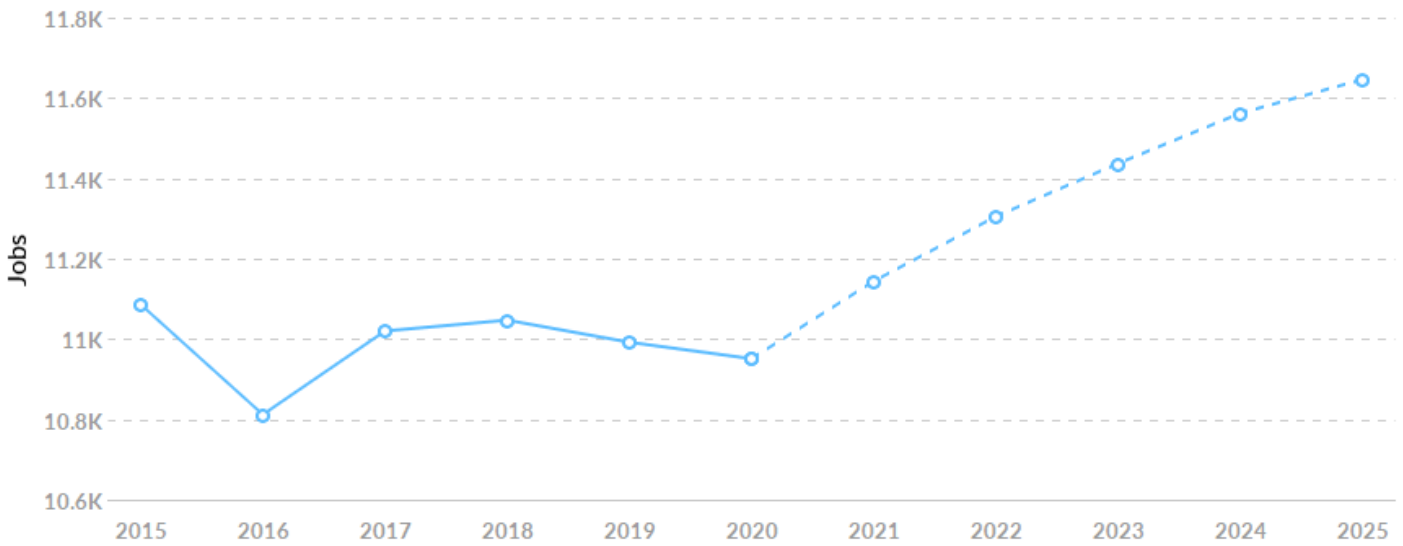

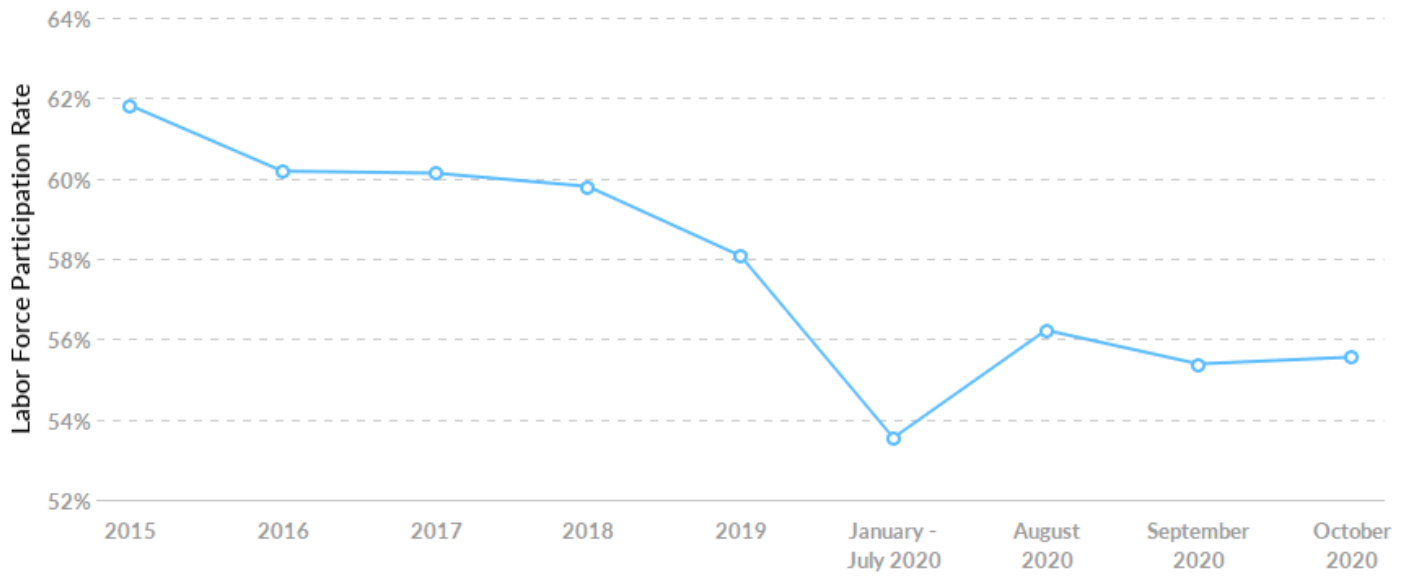
Job Trends

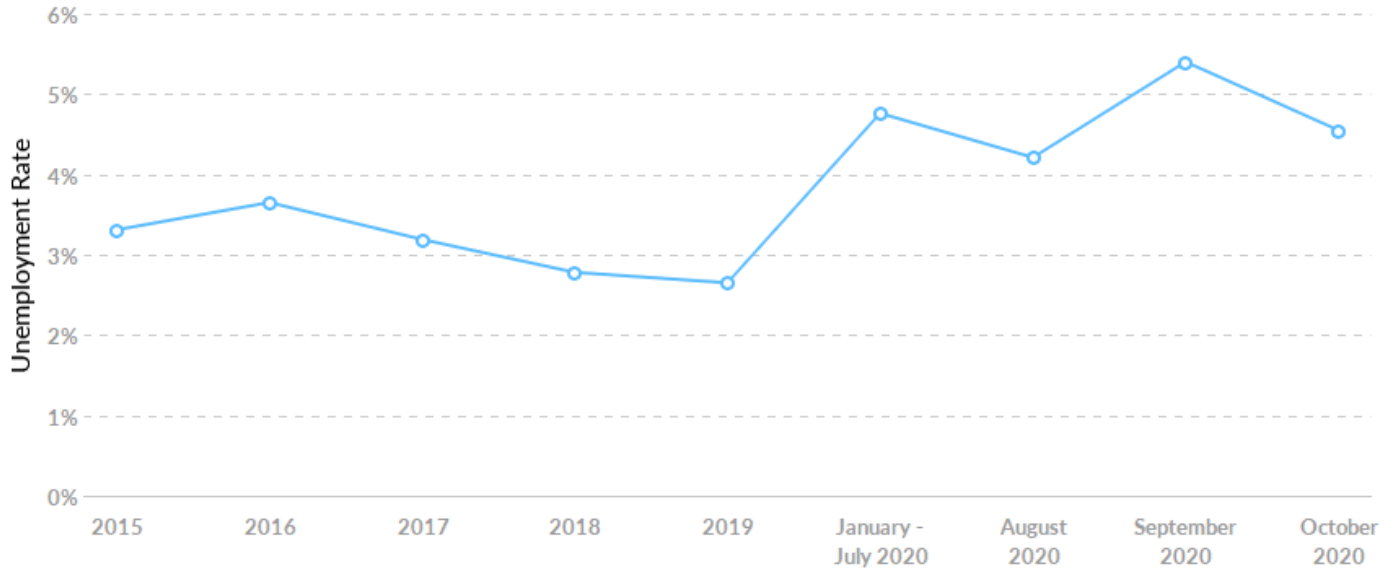

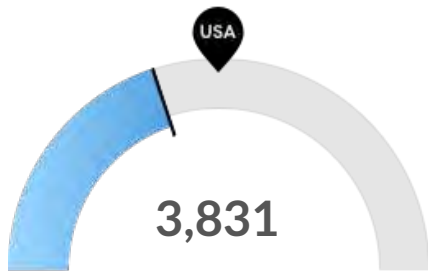
Unemployment Rate Trends

Fayette County, TX had an October 2020 unemployment rate of 4.55%, **increasing from 3.31%** 5 years before.



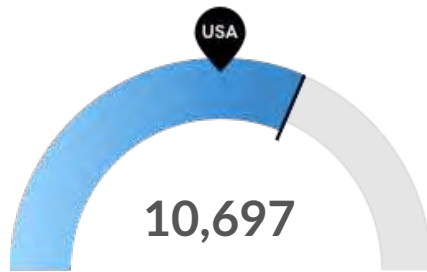

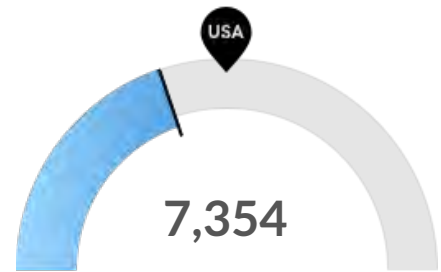
Millennials

Fayette County, TX has 3,831 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,226.



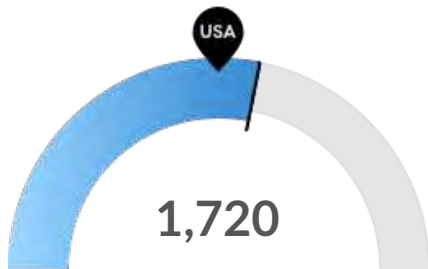
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Fayette County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 7,452 people 55 or older, while there are 10,697 here.



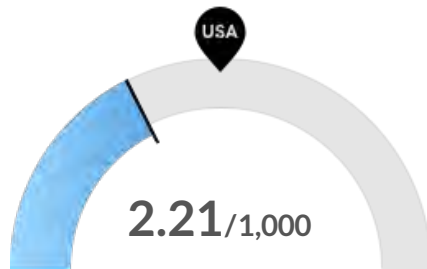
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Fayette County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 10,110 racially diverse people, while there are 7,354 here.



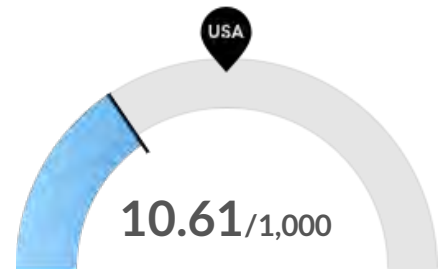
Veterans

Fayette County, TX has 2.21 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

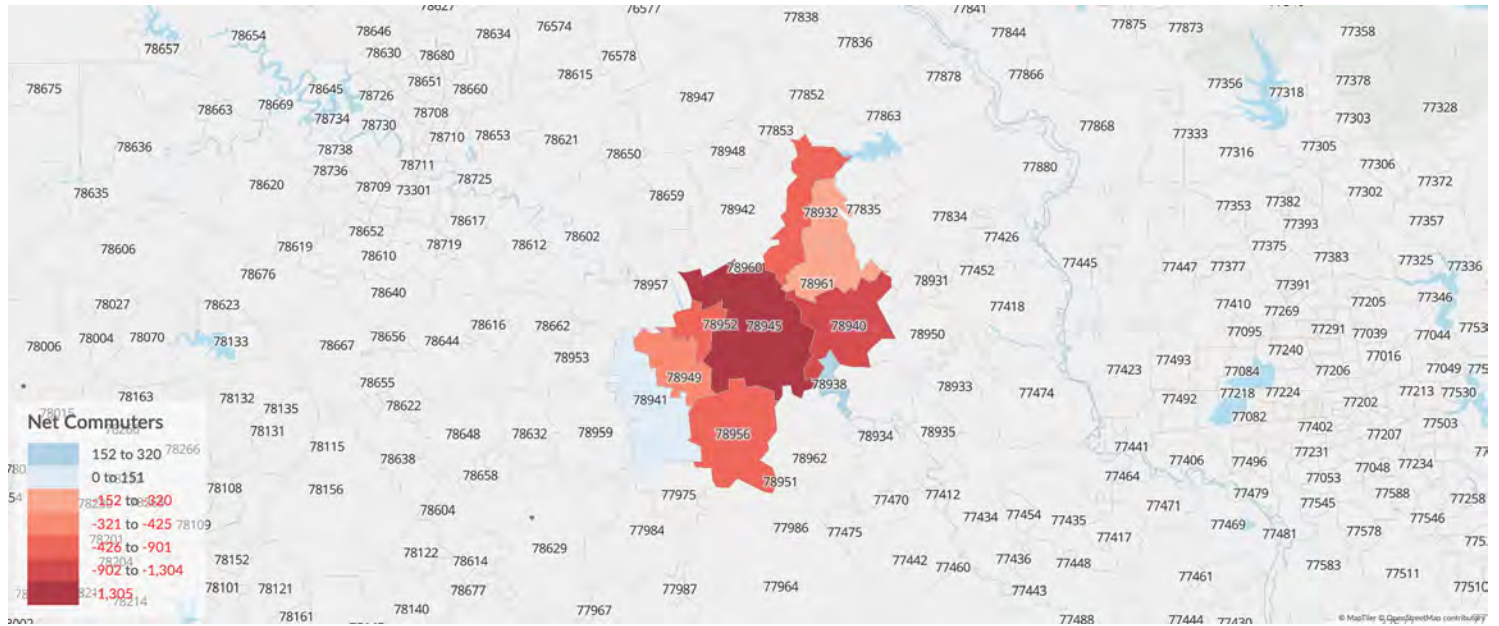


Property Crime

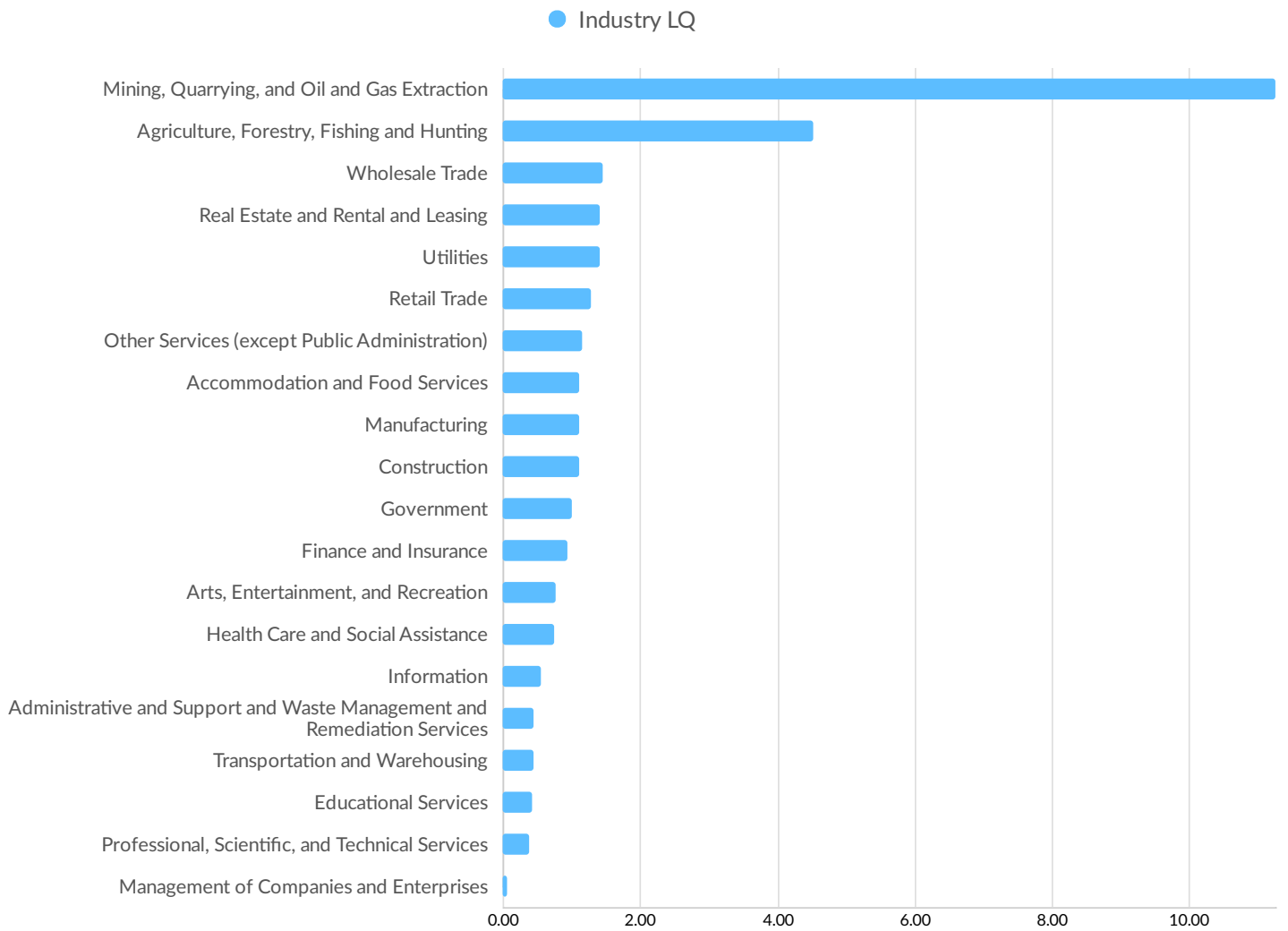

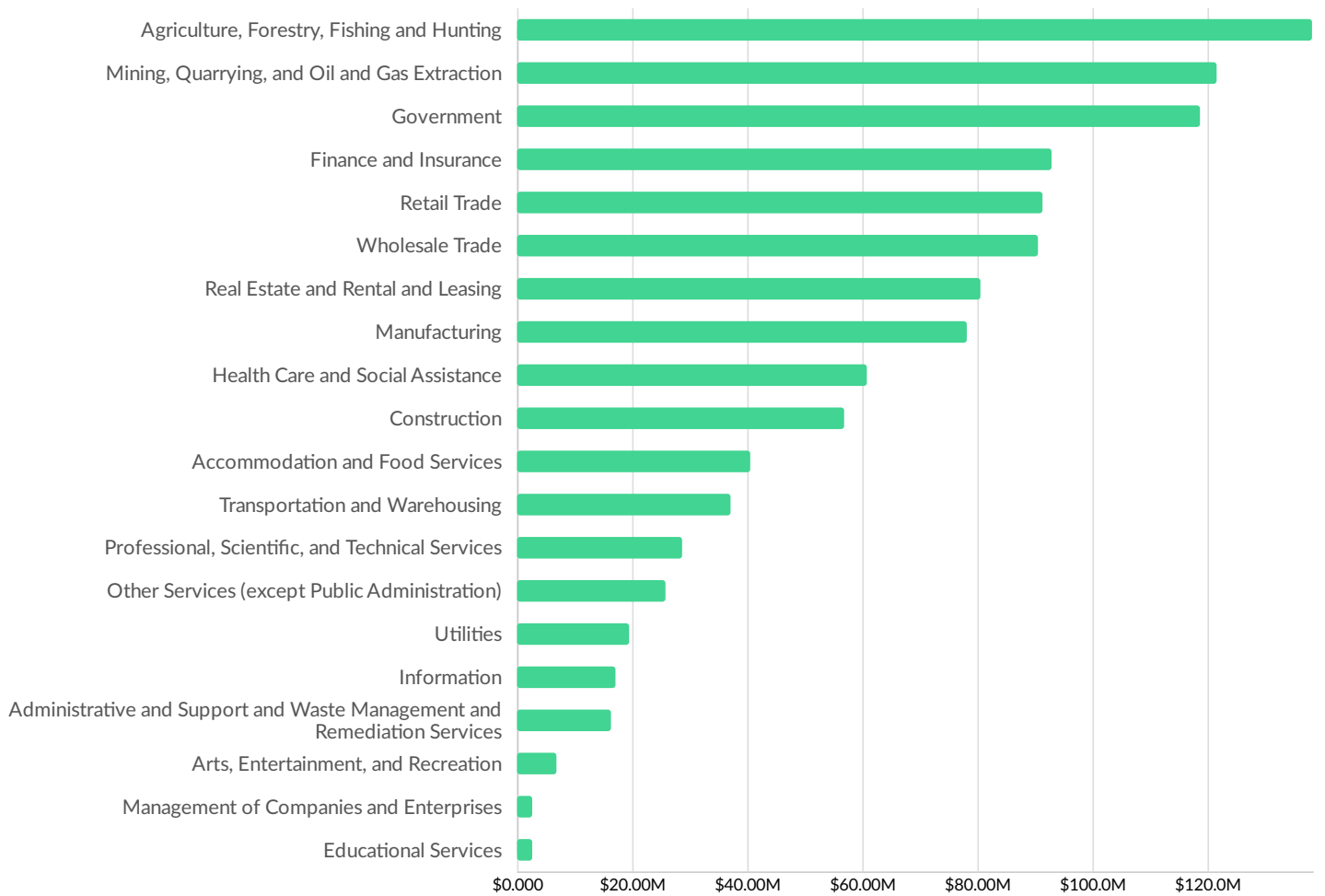


Top Industry LQ

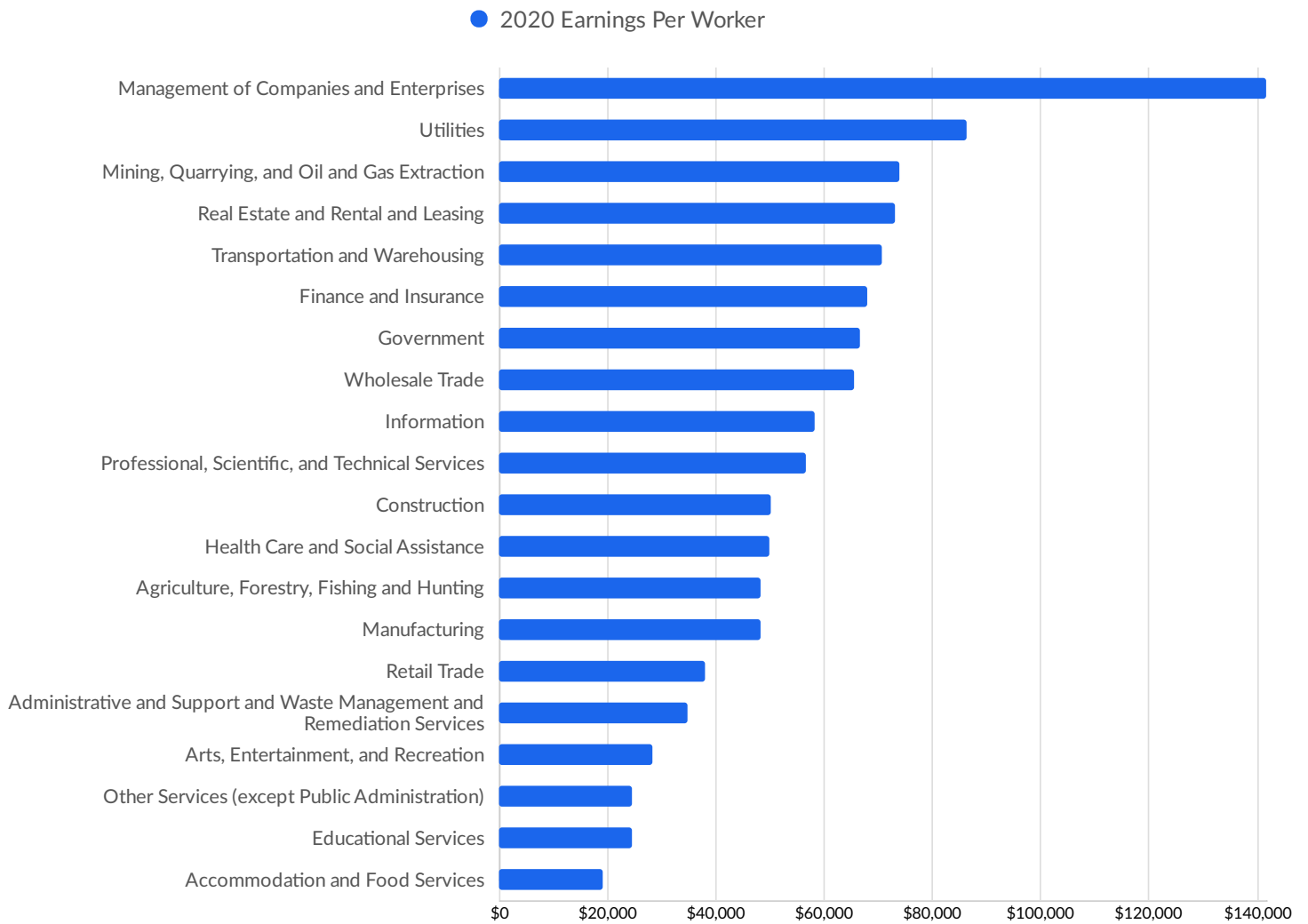


Top Industry GRP

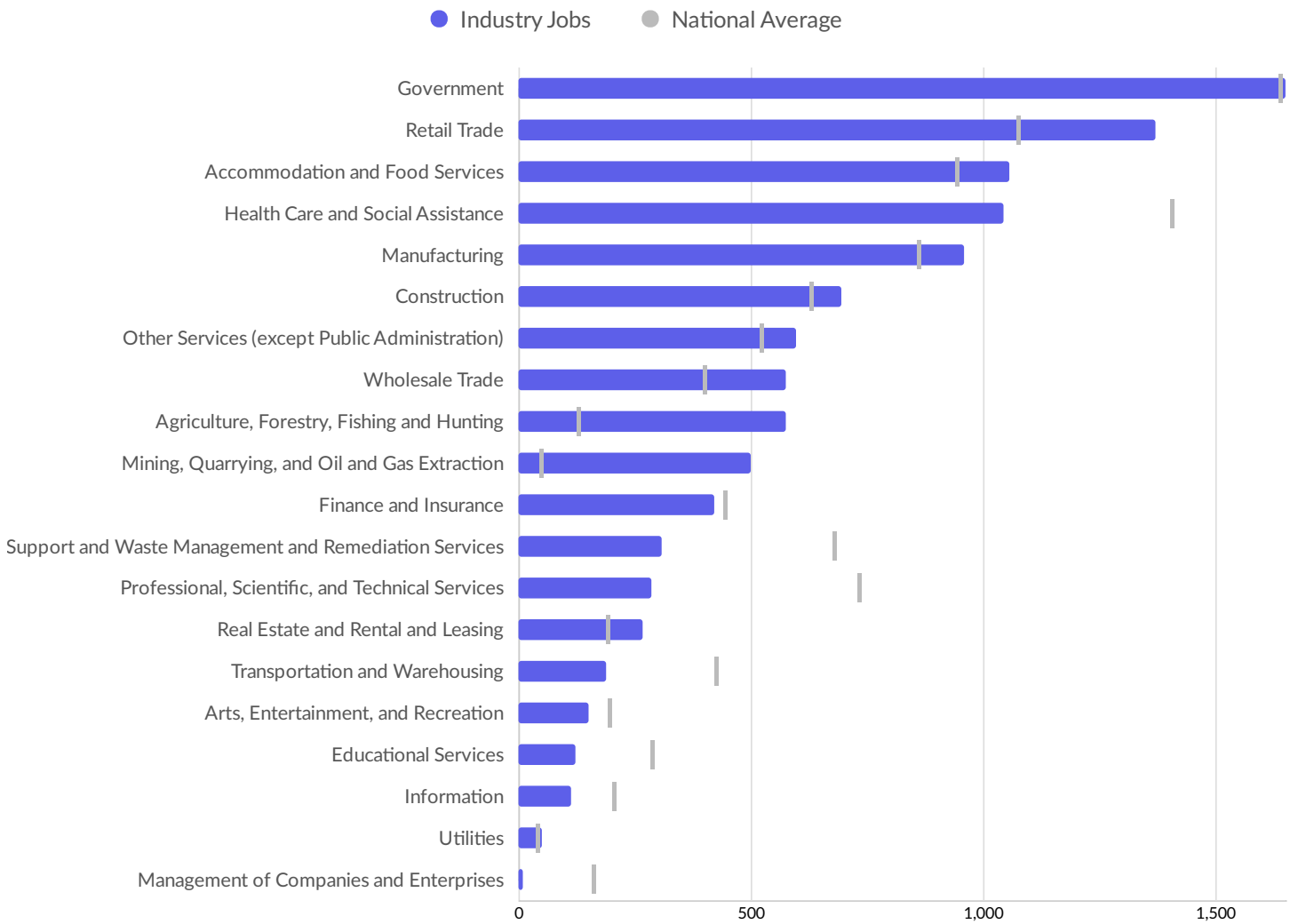

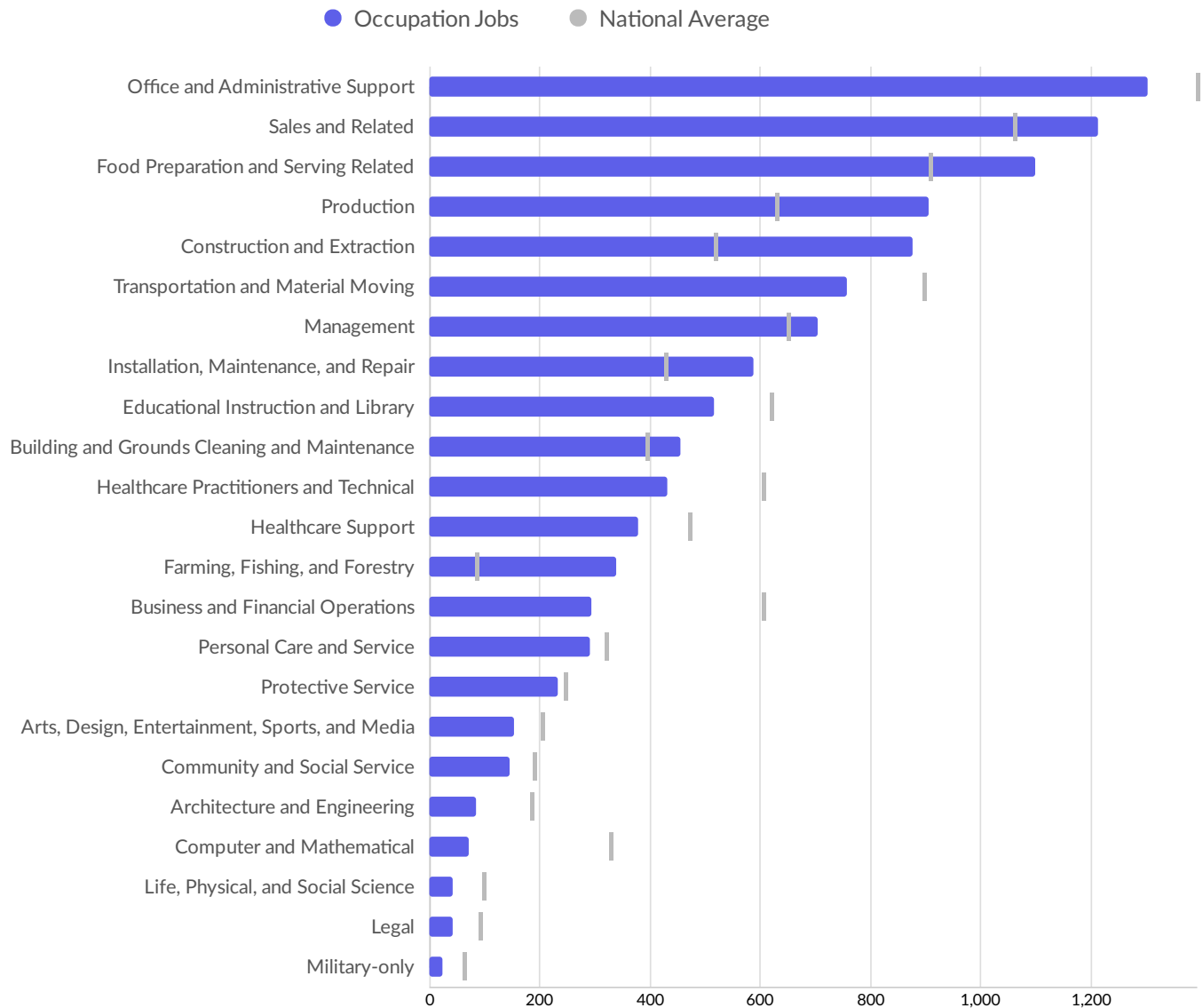

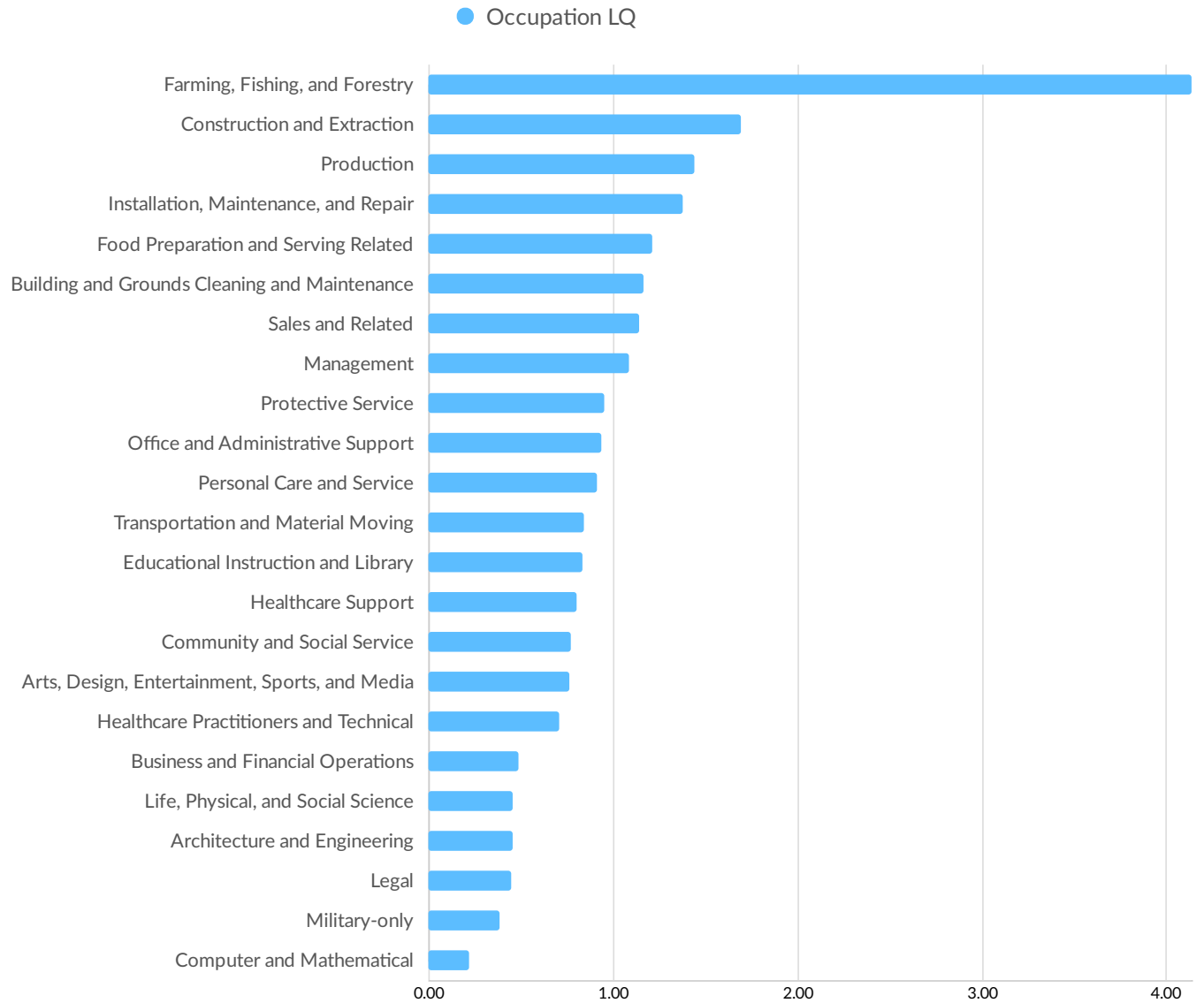

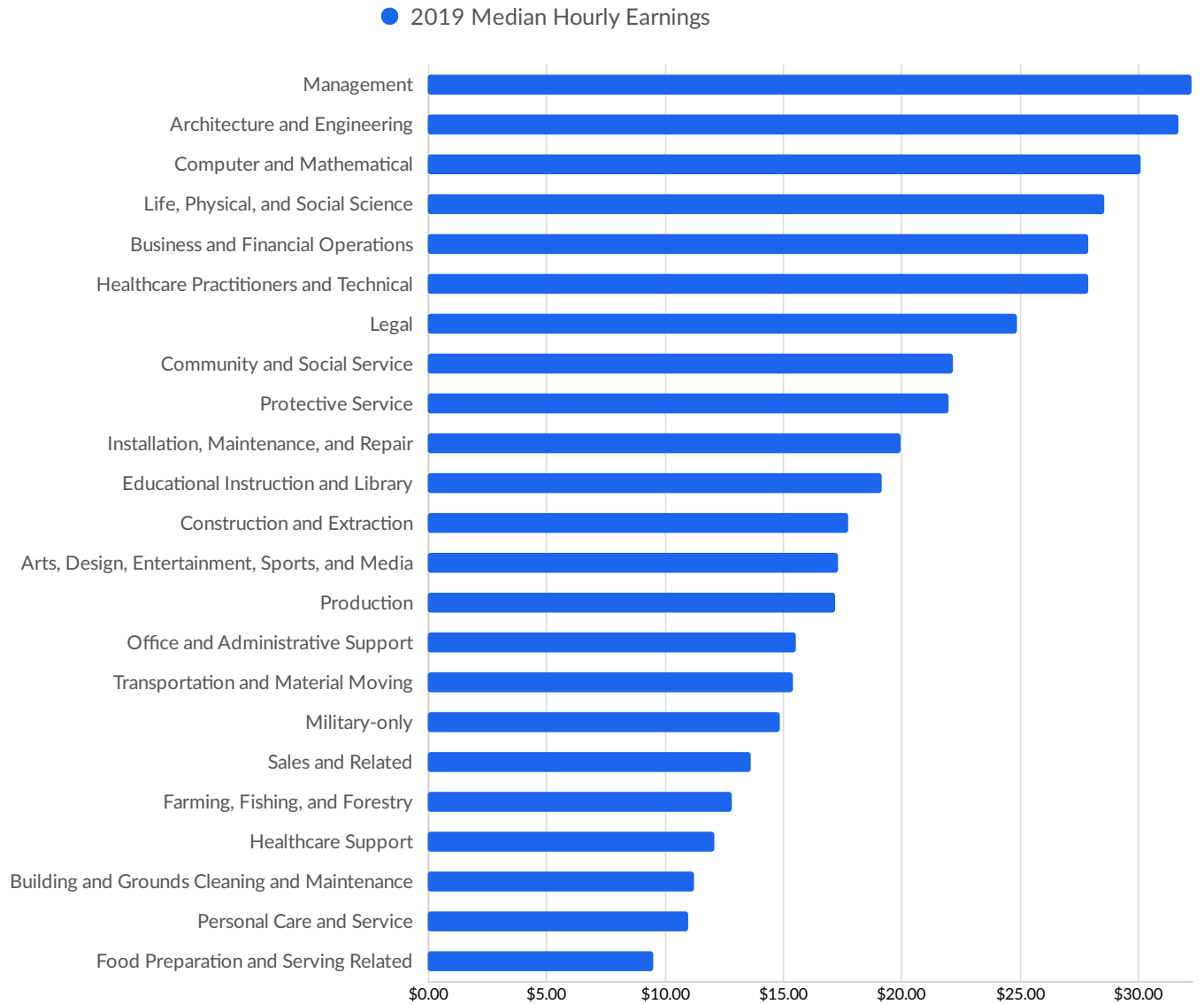
Top Growing Occupations



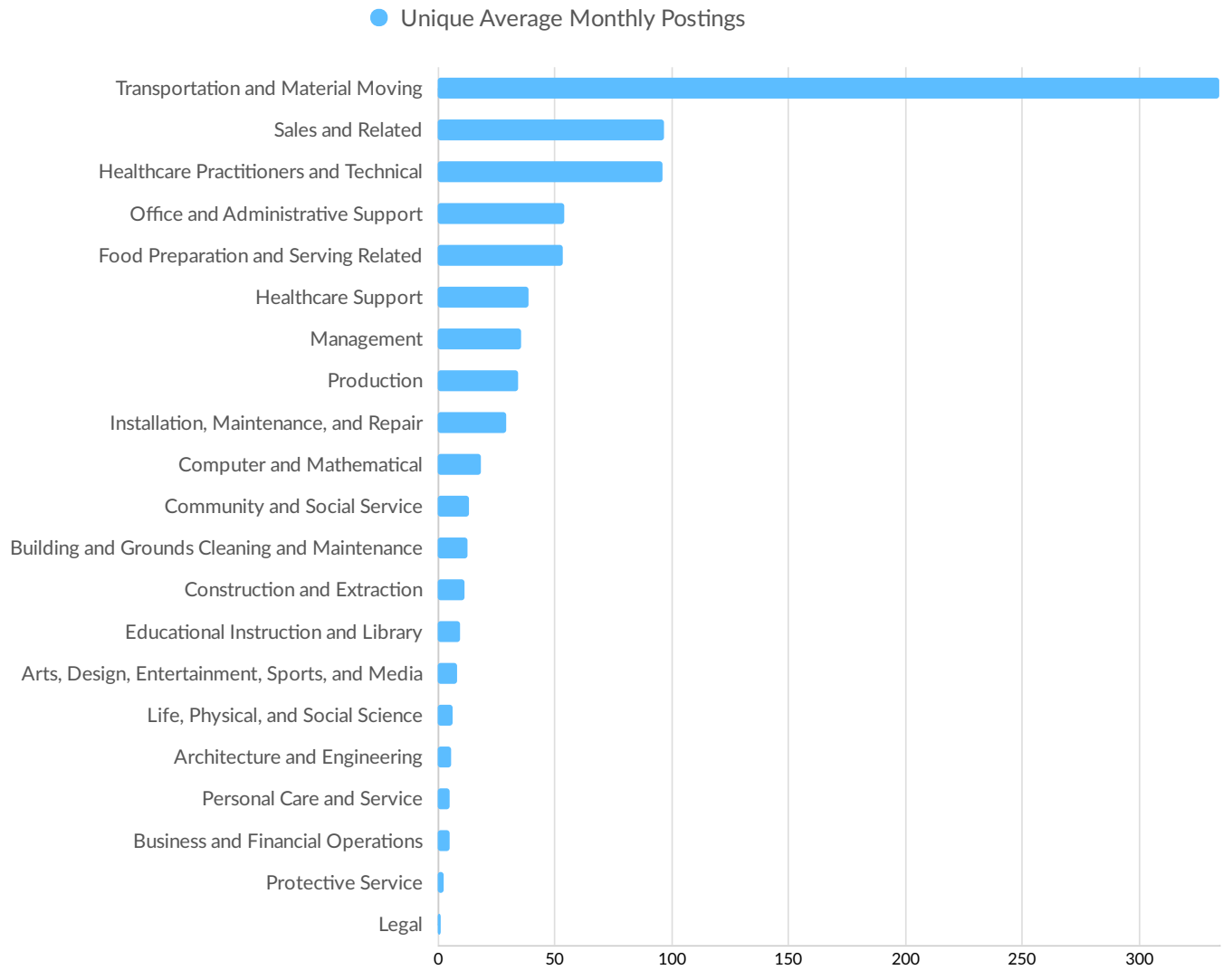

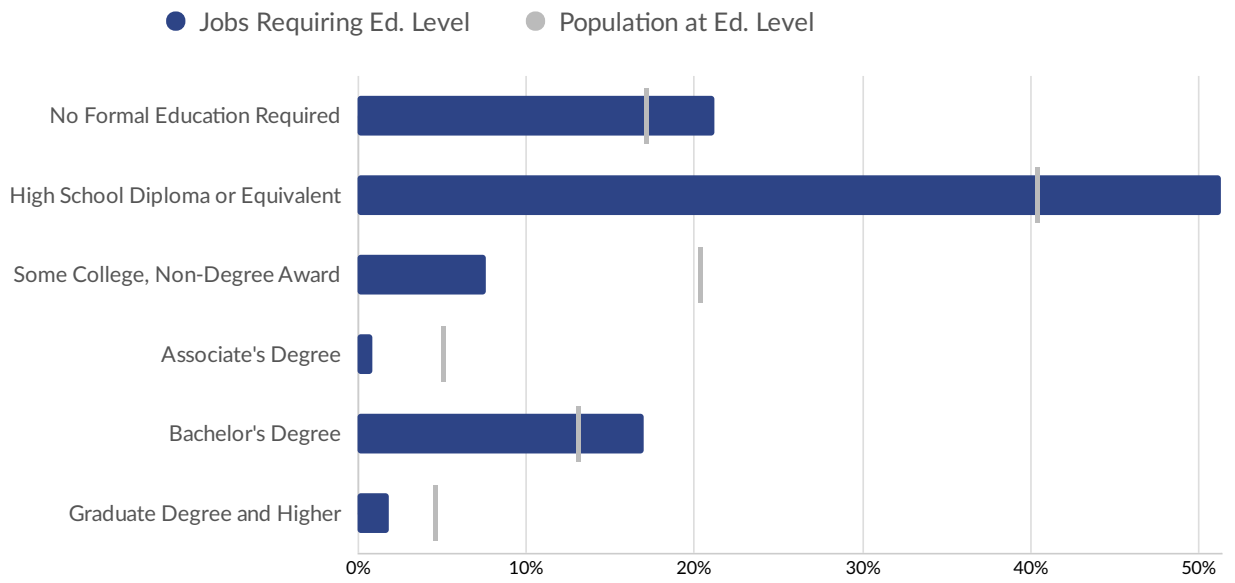

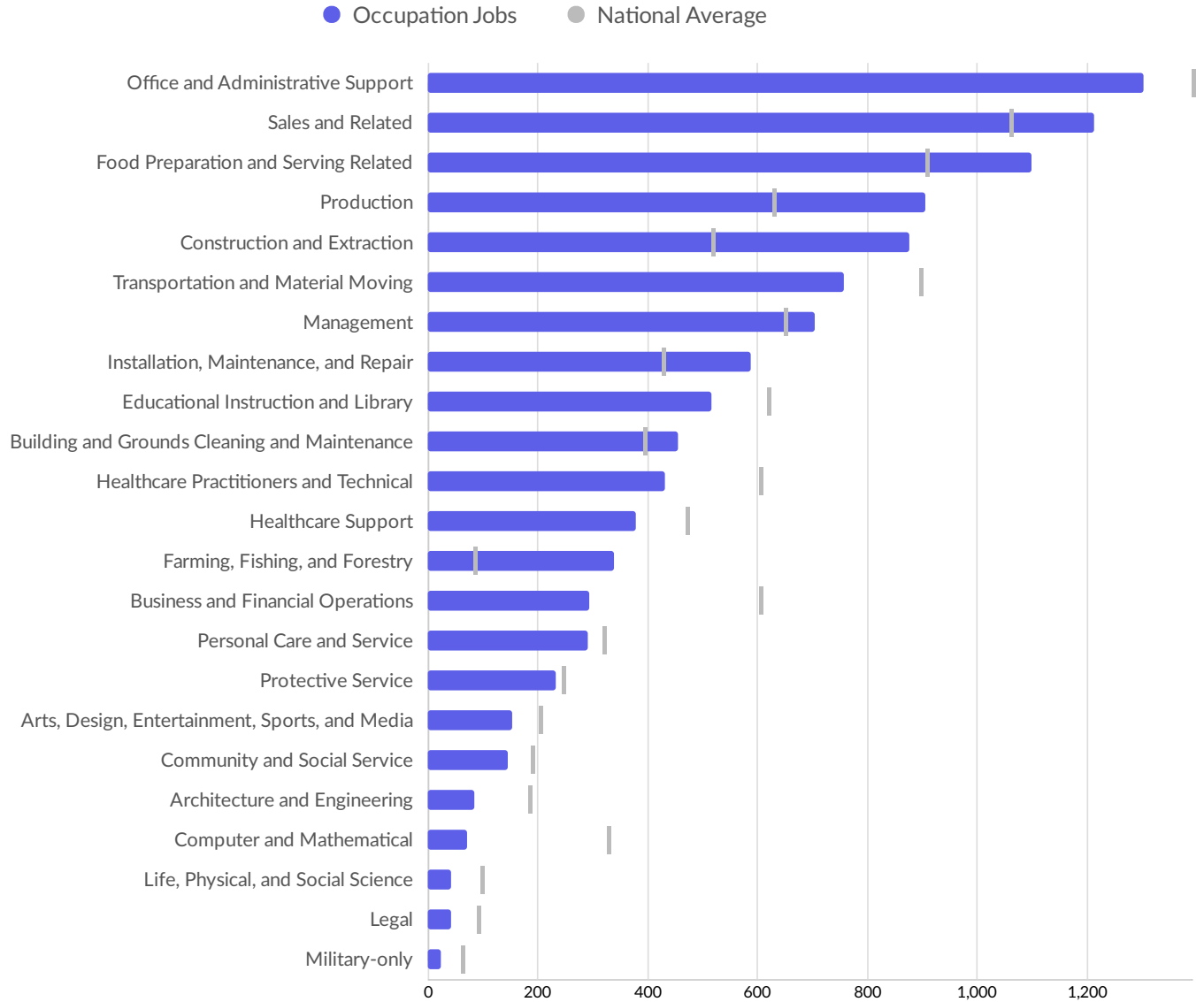
