- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.2% since 2015, growing by 166. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2020 and 2025, adding 136.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 3.9% in Goliad County, TX from 1,667 to 1,732. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 55.0% to 50.3% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.7% of Goliad County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.3% below the national average), and **10.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.



As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.2% since 2015, growing by 166. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2020 and 2025, adding 136.






Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Goliad County, TX has 1,211 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,579.




Veterans

Goliad County, TX has 558 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 432.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is about average in Goliad County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 3,055 racially diverse people, while there are 3,206 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Occupations








