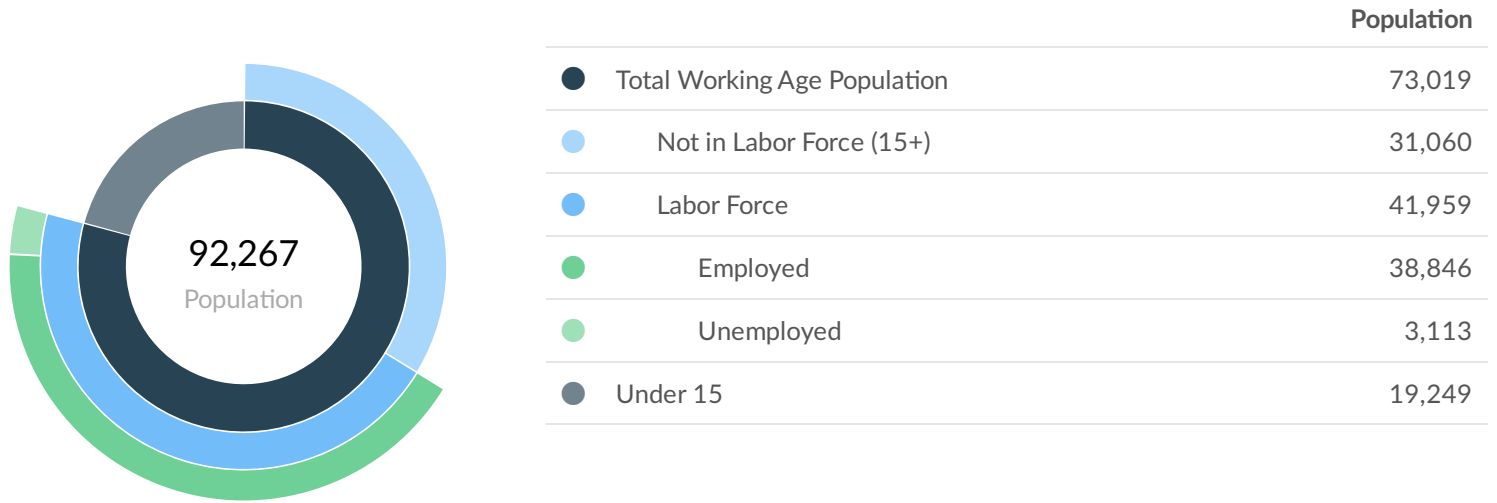
Median household income is **\$4.7K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.1%** since 2015, growing by 131. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 476.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 6.8%** in Victoria County, TX from 46,153 to **43,013**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 13.0%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 62.1% to 57.5% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Victoria County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.9% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

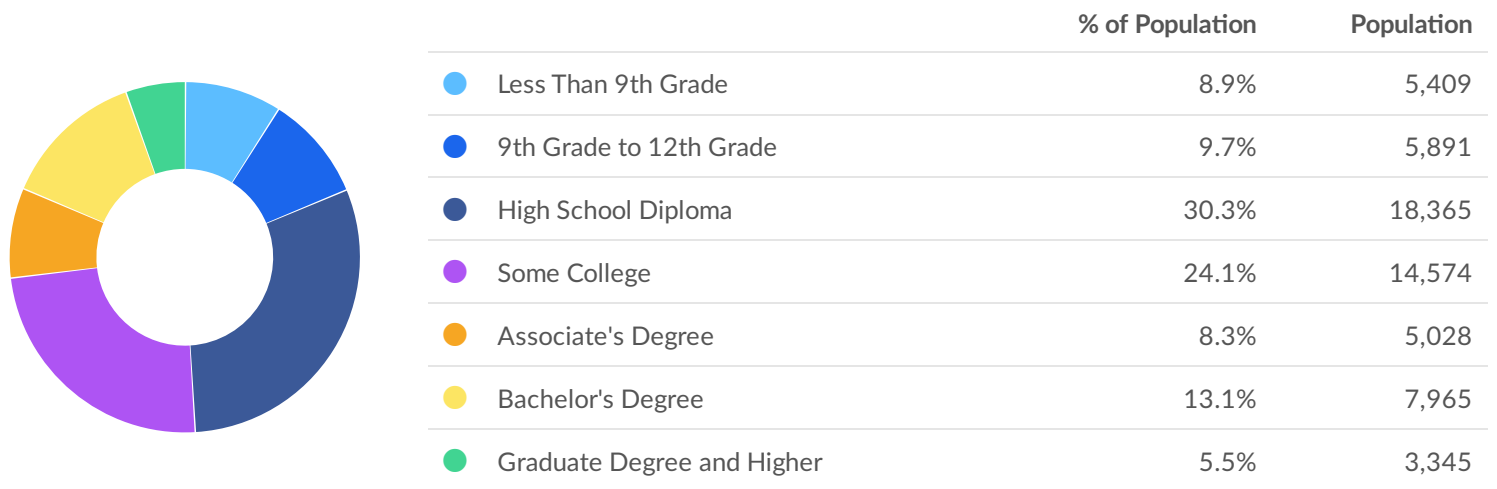

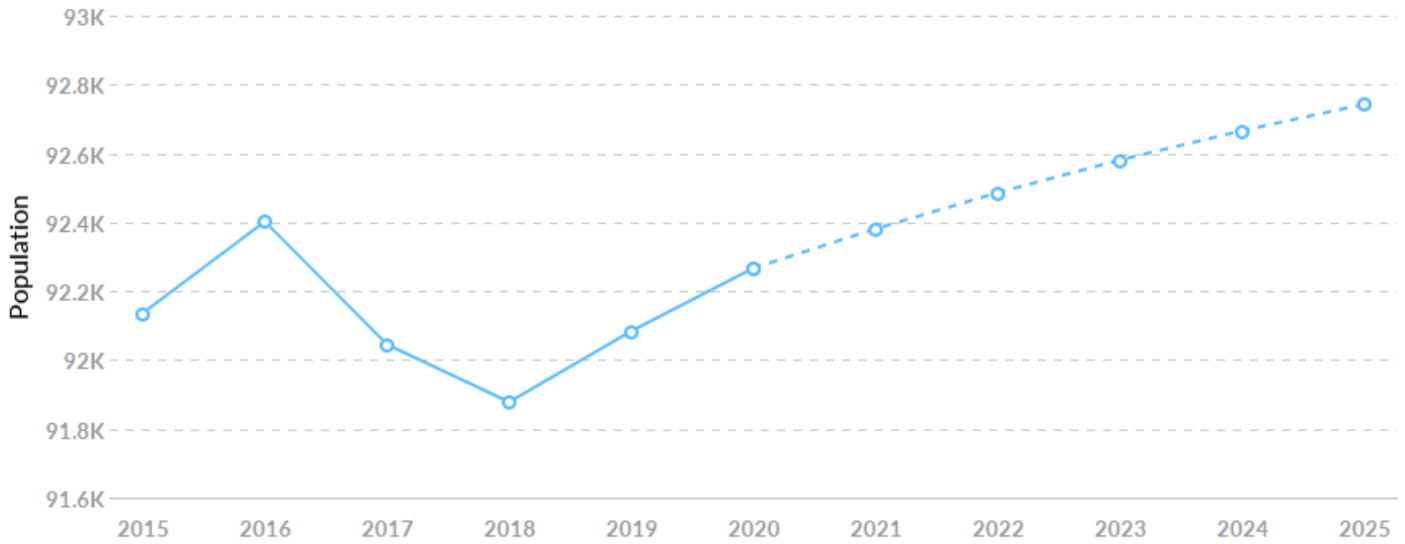

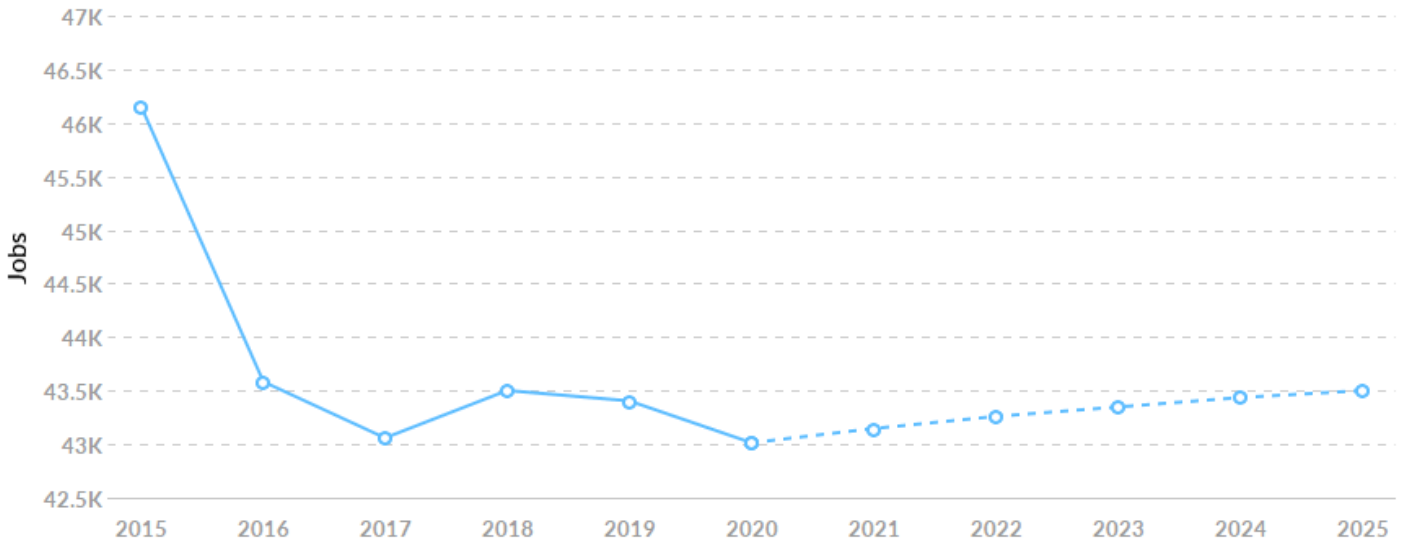

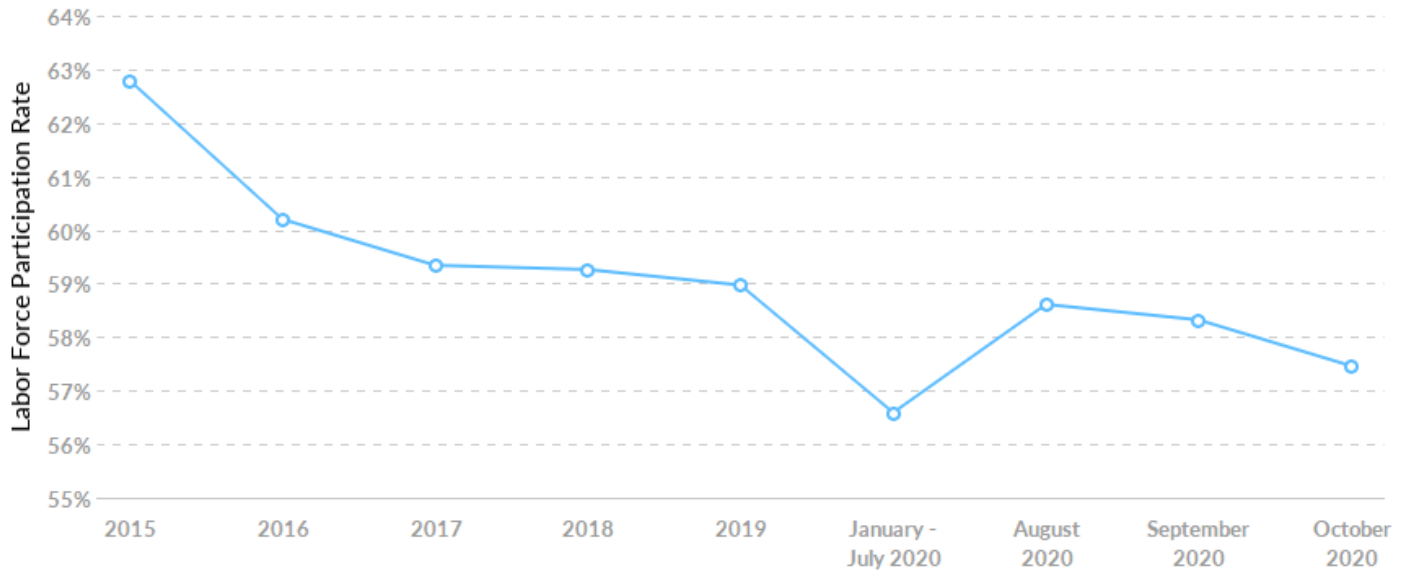
Job Trends

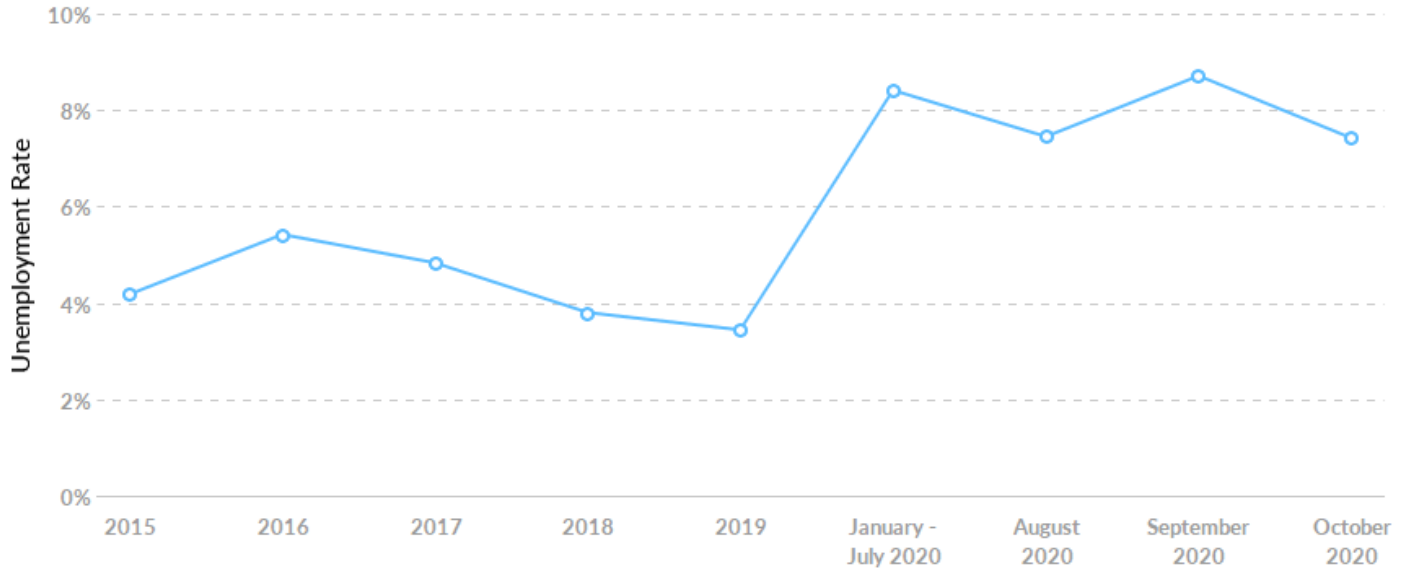

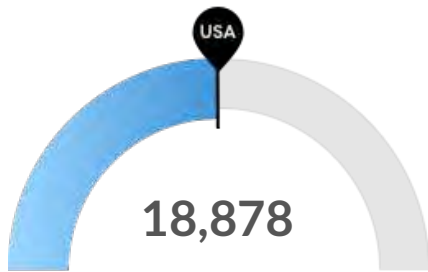
Unemployment Rate Trends

Victoria County, TX had an October 2020 unemployment rate of 7.42%, **increasing from 4.18%** 5 years before.



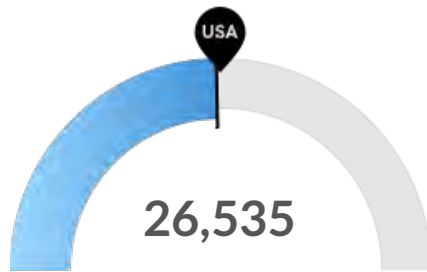

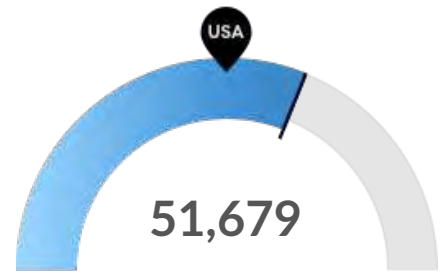
Millennials

Victoria County, TX has 18,878 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 18,986.



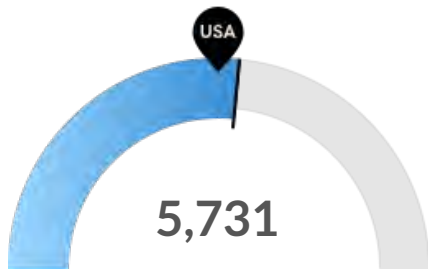
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Victoria County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 27,074 people 55 or older, while there are 26,535 here.



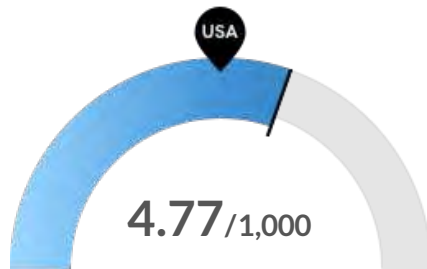
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Victoria County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 36,731 racially diverse people, while there are 51,679 here.



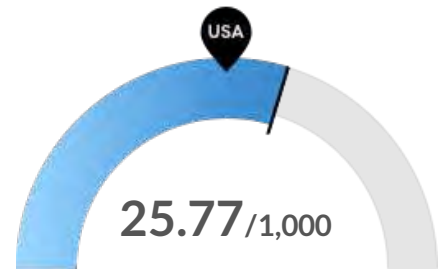
Veterans

Victoria County, TX has 4.77 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

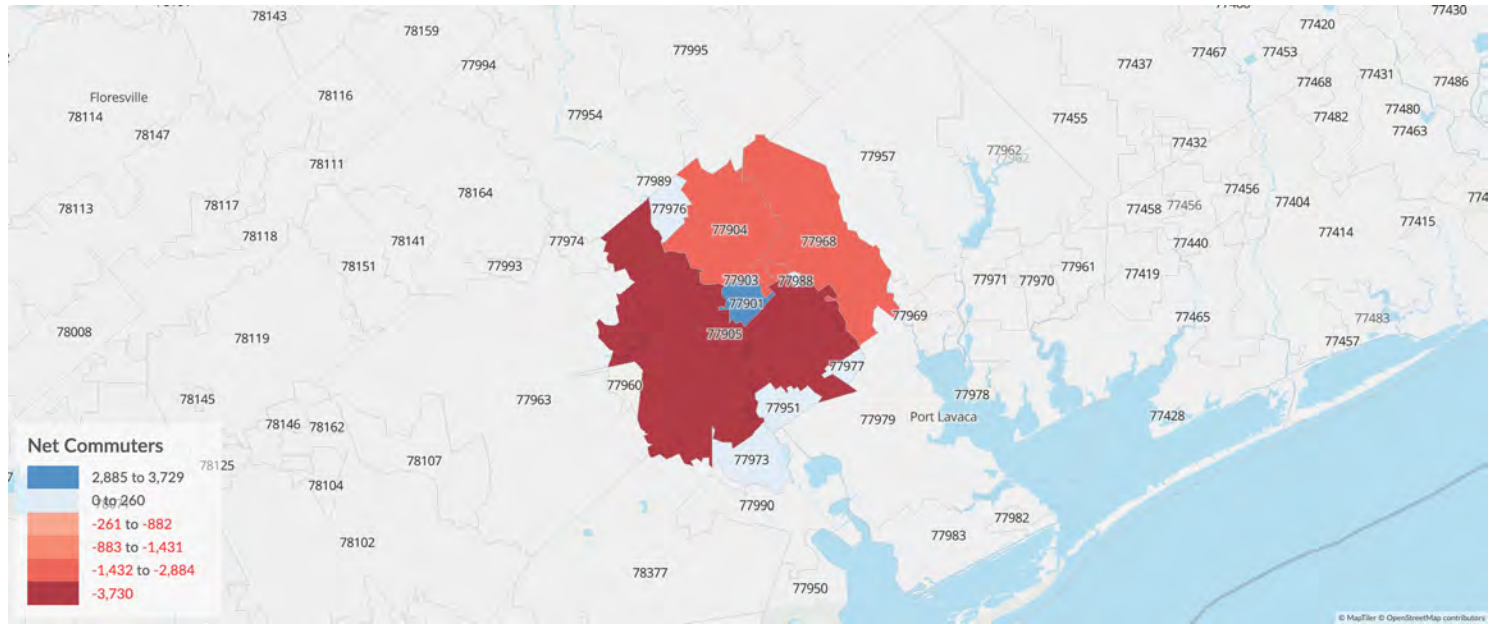


Property Crime

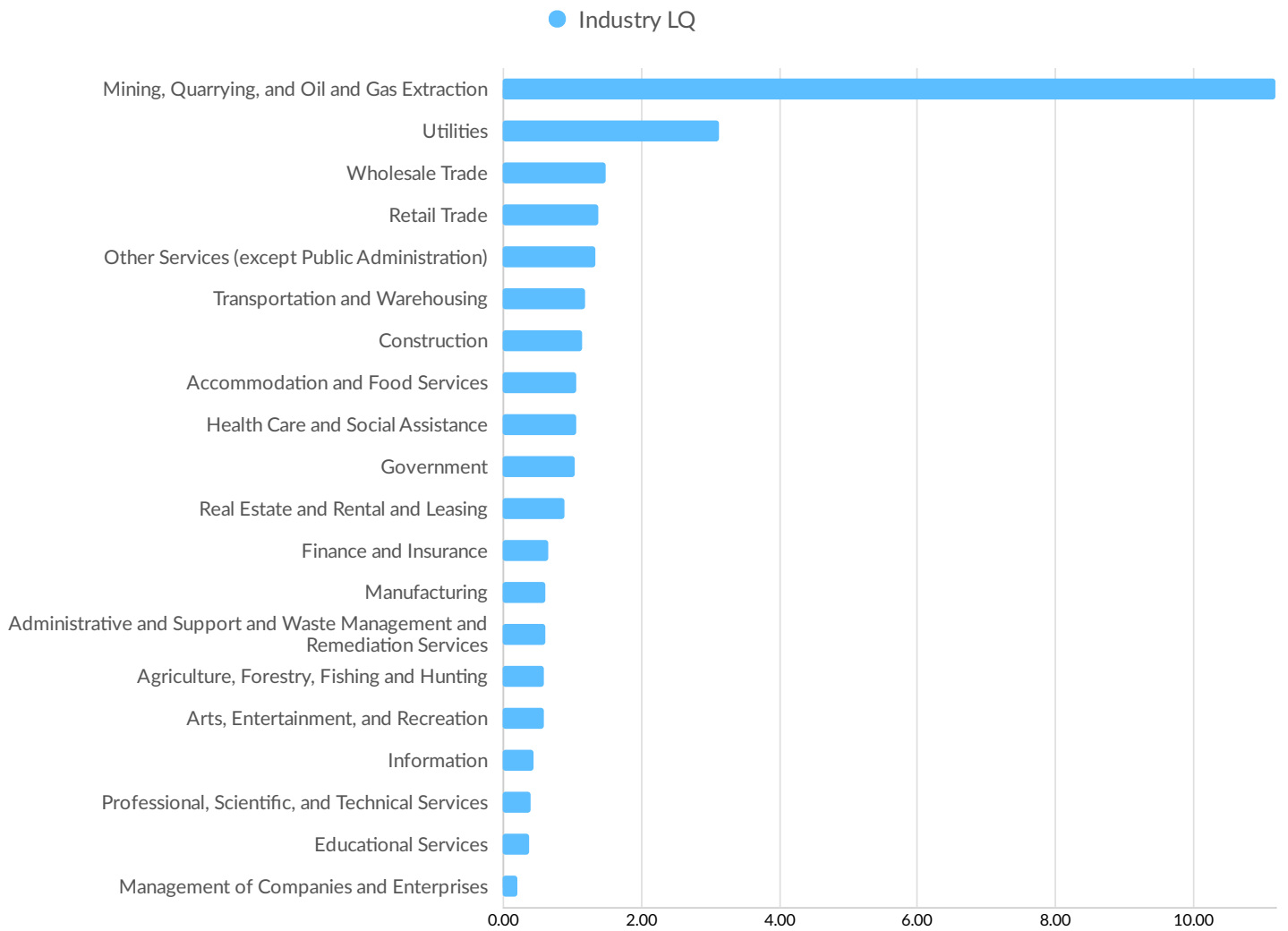

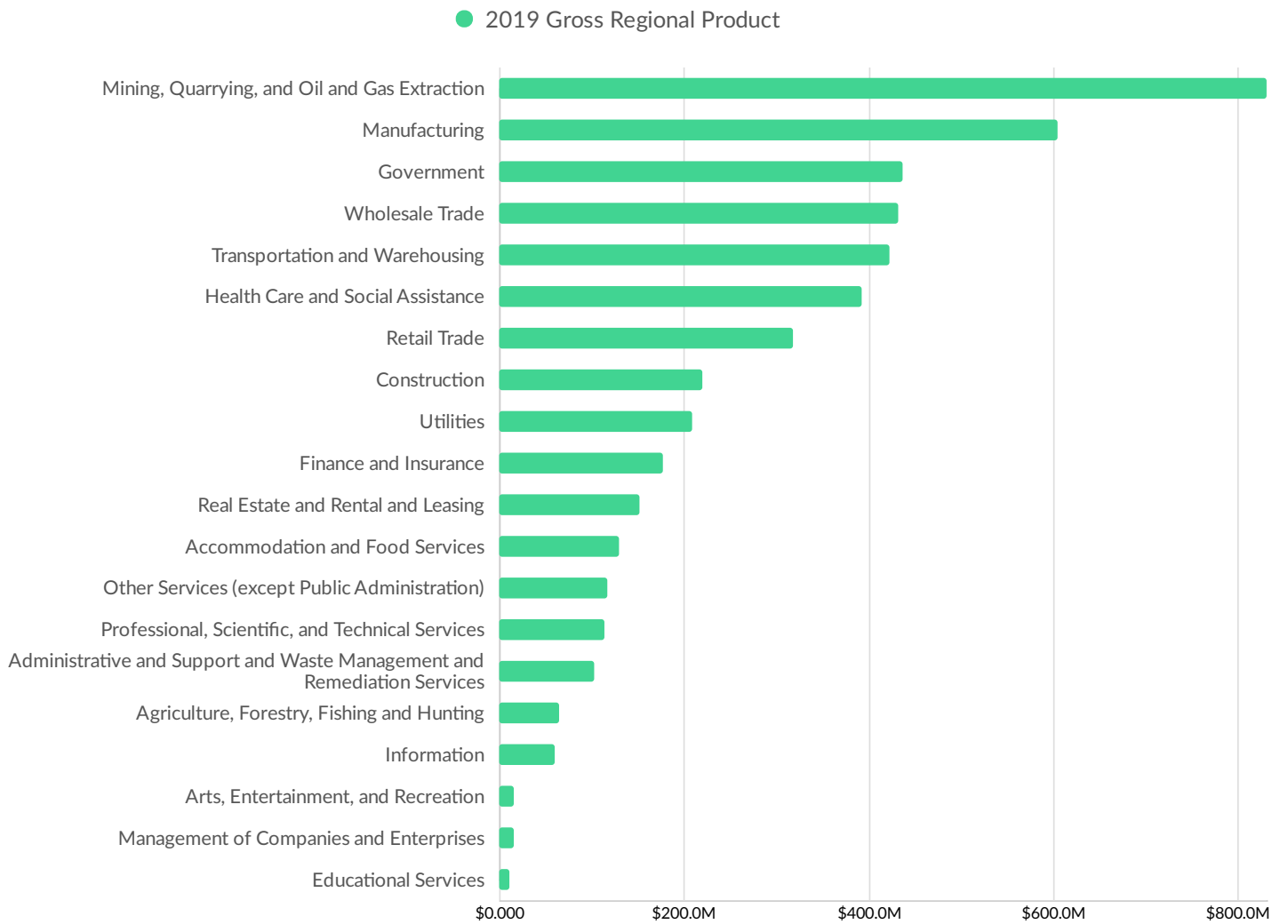
Top Growing Industries



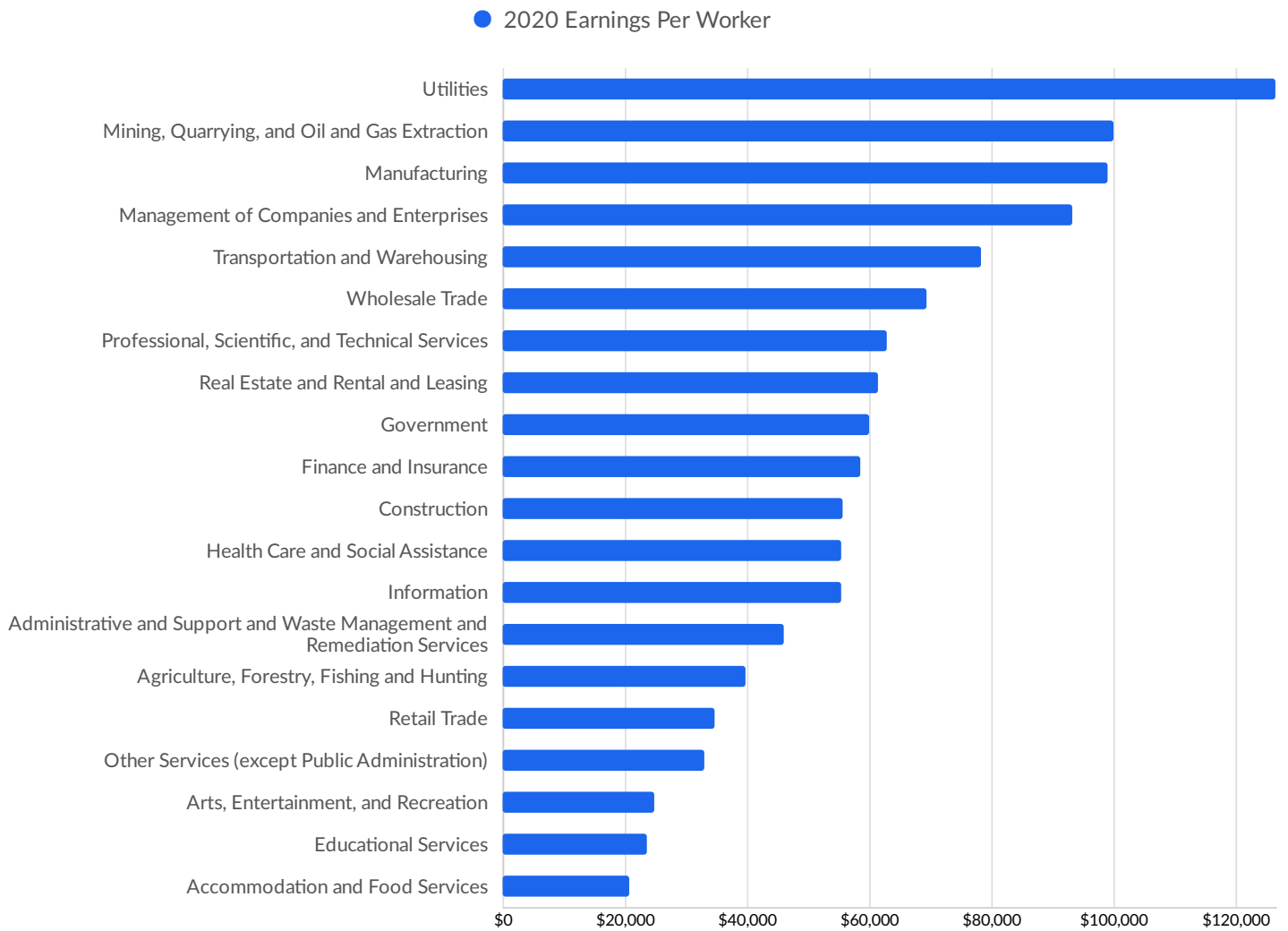

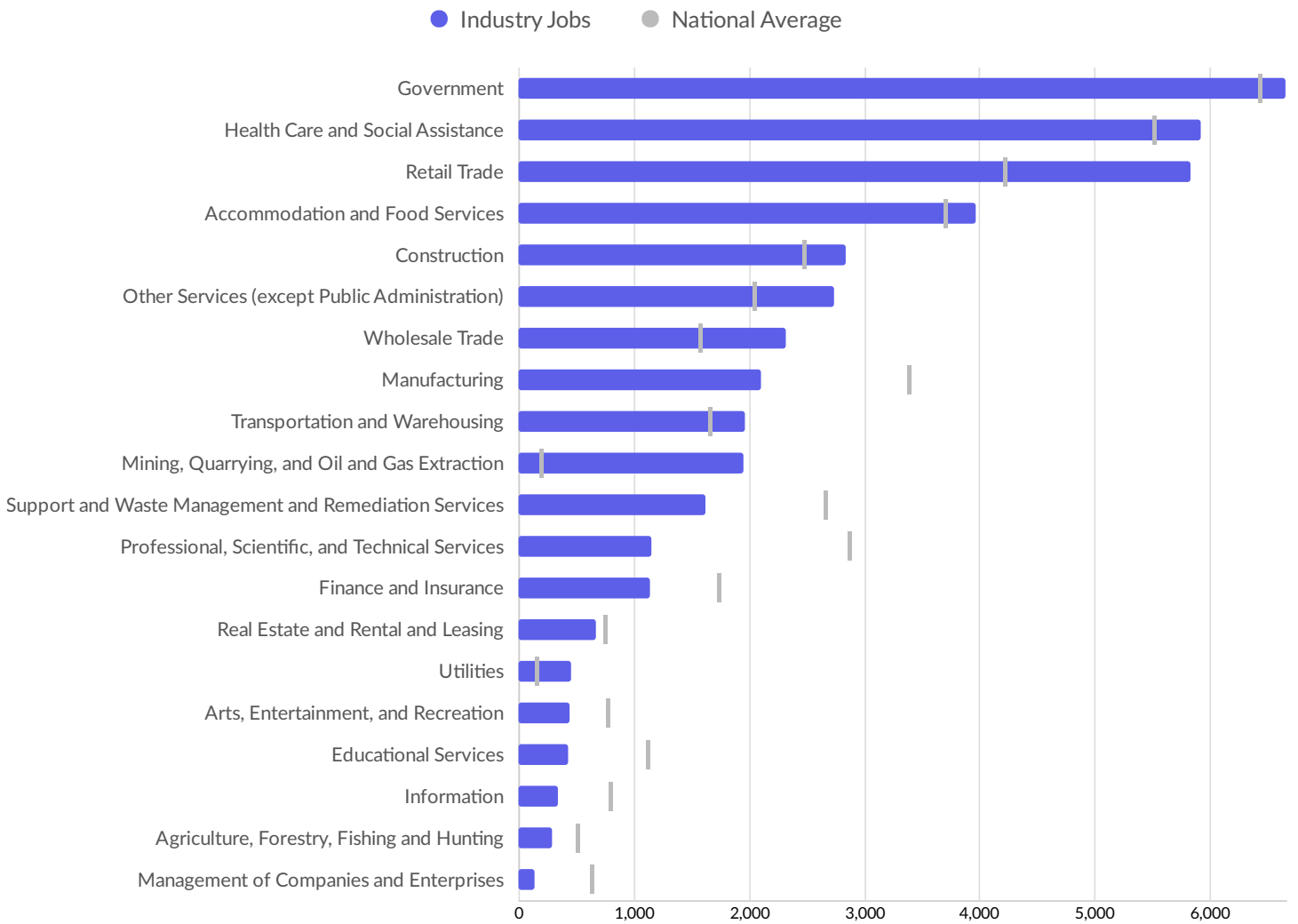

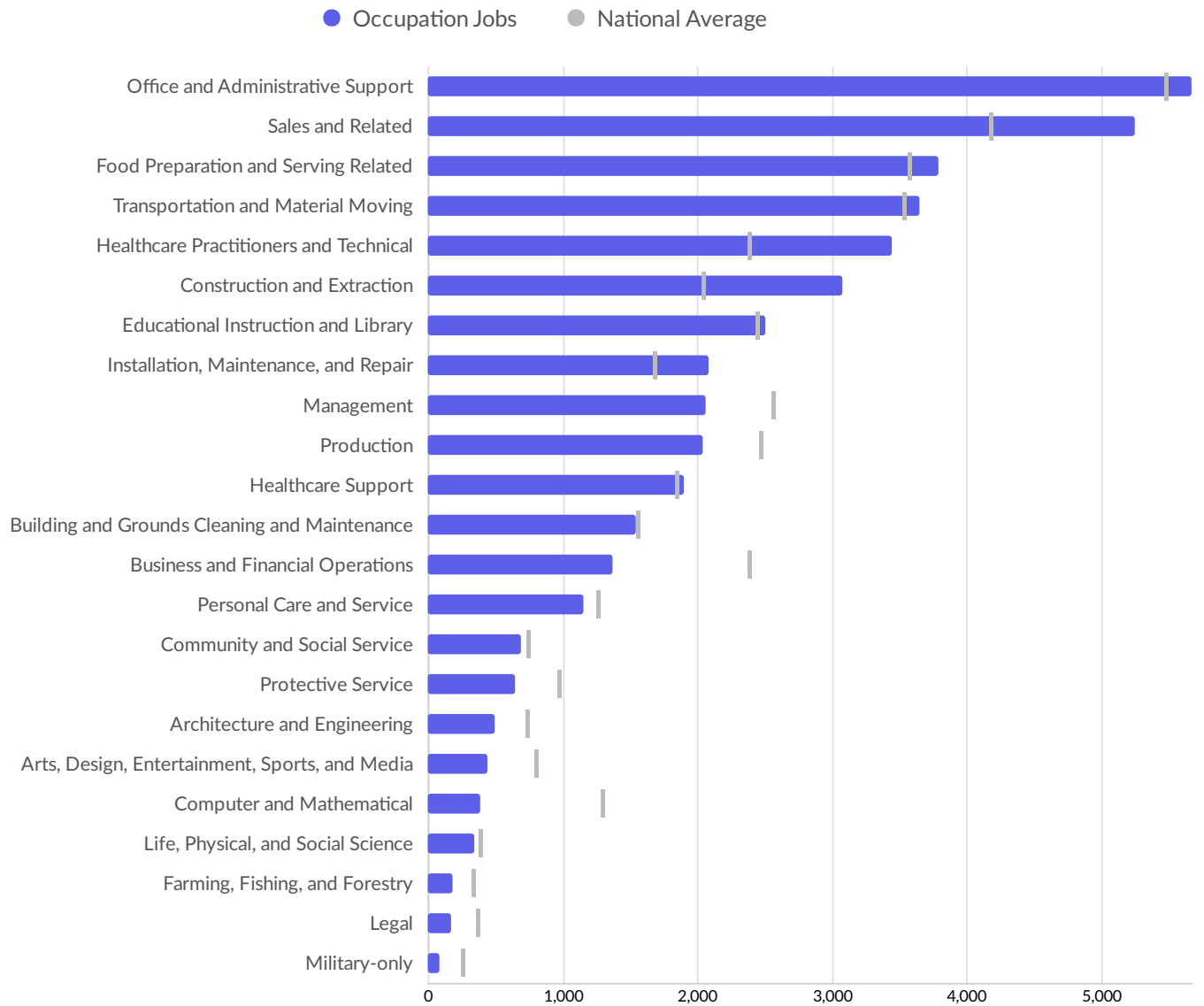

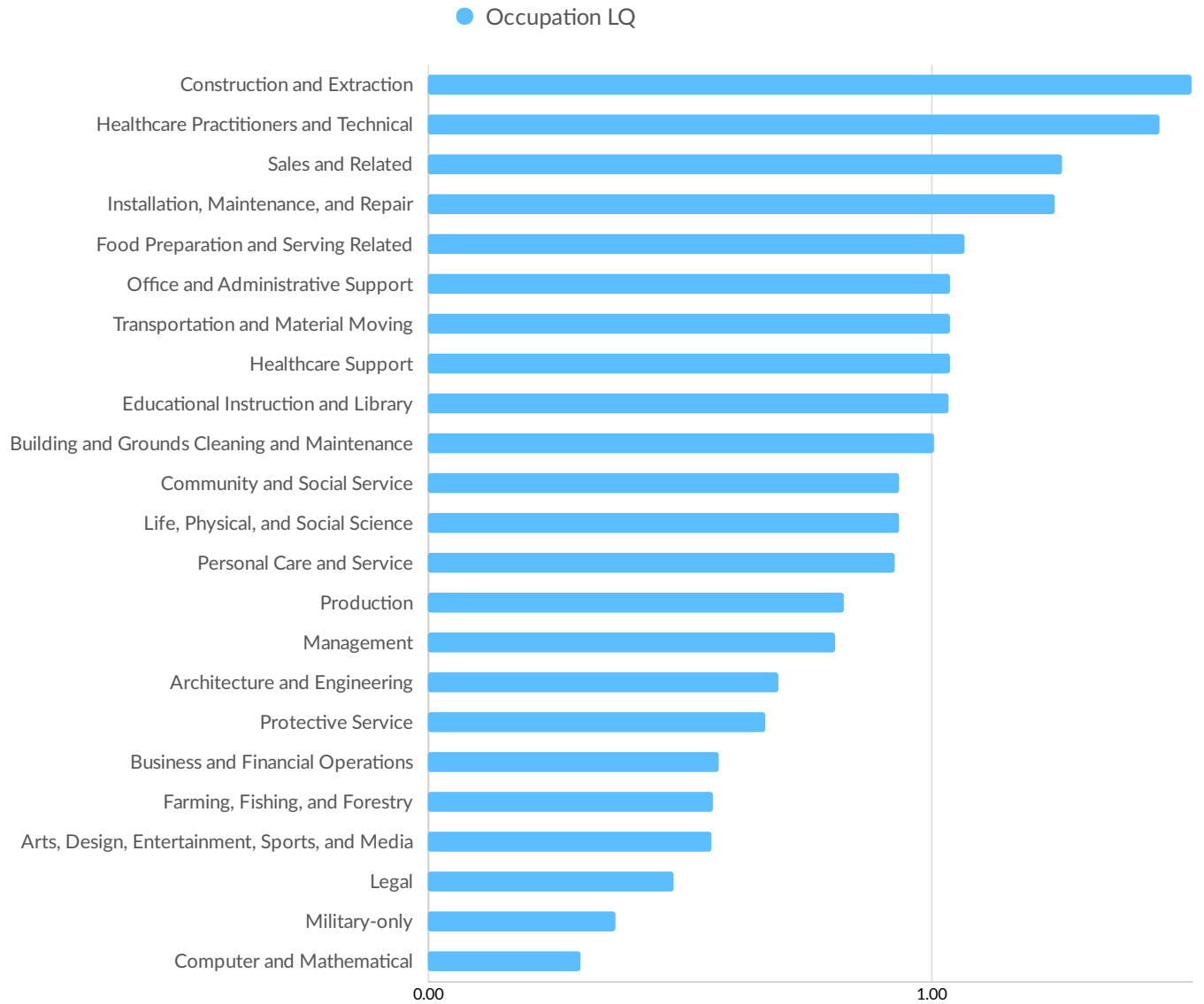

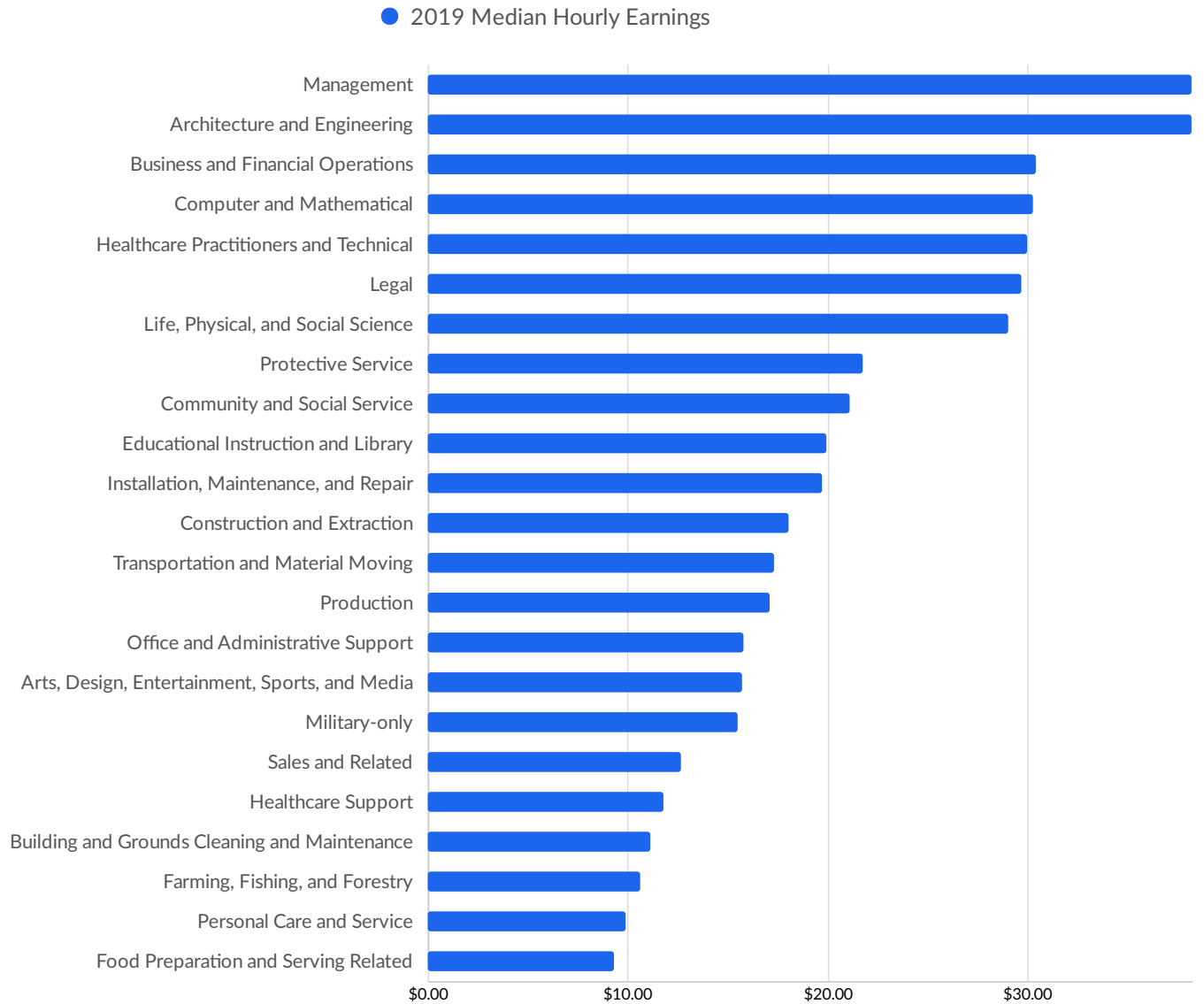
Top Growing Occupations



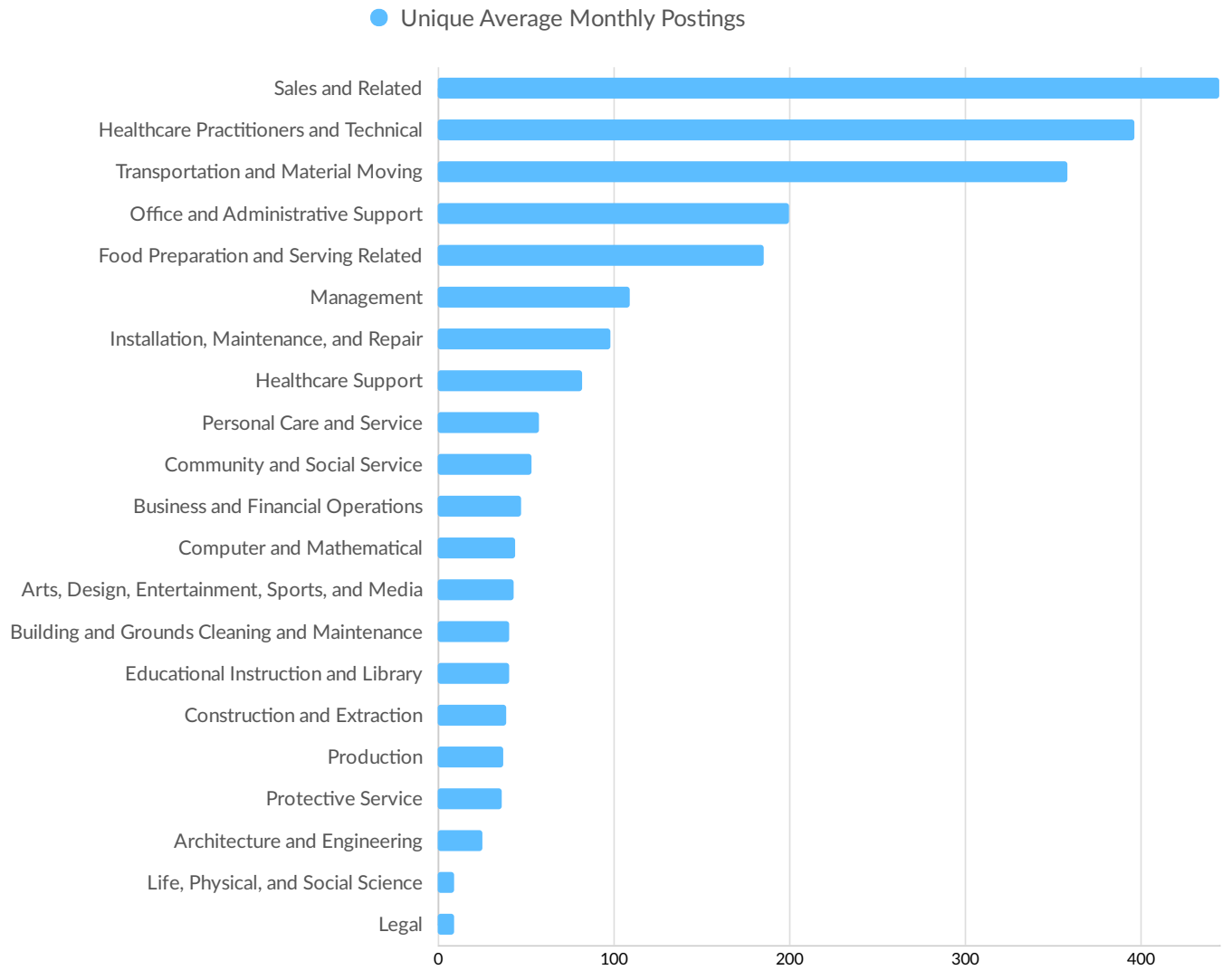

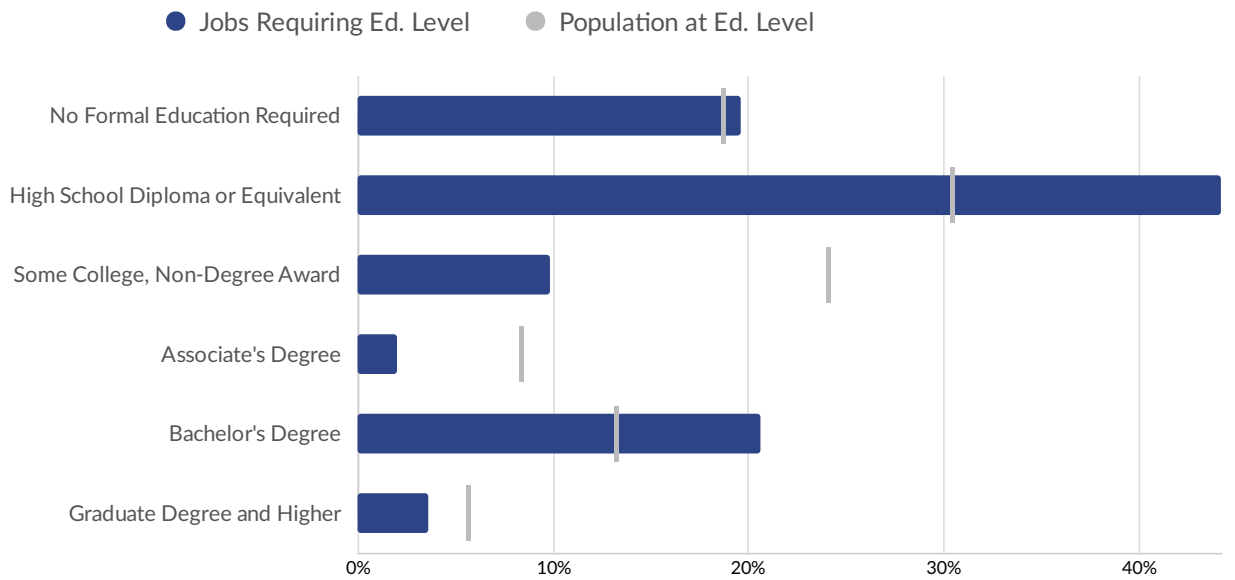

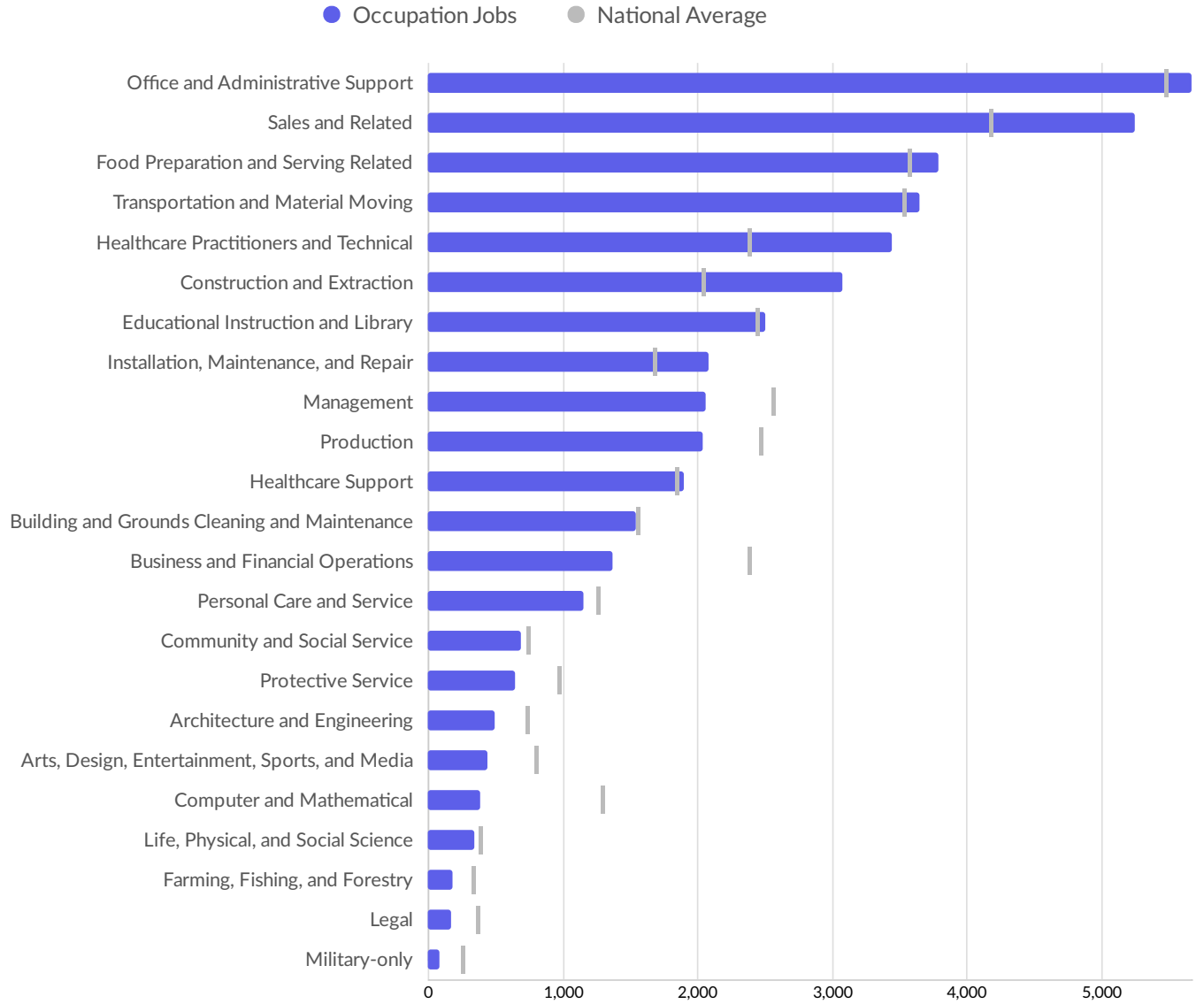


