
Median household income is \$7.3K below the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 0.0% in Lavaca County, TX from 6,746 to 6,744. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 6.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.9% to 49.8% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Lavaca County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.0% below the national average), and **6.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Animal Slaughtering and Processing, and Nursing Care Facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities).








Unemployment Rate Trends

Lavaca County, TX had an October 2020 unemployment rate of 5.43%, increasing from 3.78% 5 years before.








Millennials

Lavaca County, TX has 1,312 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,146.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Lavaca County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 8,039 racially diverse people, while there are 5,473 here.




Property Crime





Top Industry GRP











2019 Median Hourly Earnings






